

## CONTROLS

Am-Source motors can be activated and controlled in a variety of ways ranging from a wall switch that controls one motor, to using a Computerized Building Control System or Home Automation System to activate any number of motors. High-Tech Systems that respond to many different commands such as time of day, wind velocity, sun sensors, to emergencies such as fire or burglar alarms.

Now anyone can stop the glare on their computer screen or television screen, by adjusting their blinds via wireless remote control.

Systems may be local or centralized or centralized with local override.

## MOTOR CONTROL RELAY MODULES

Motor Control Relays are used when more than one motor is to be controlled from one switch or central control.

## CONTROLS

The RI-2 and RI-3 is the line voltage version of the group control relays. The RI -2 and RI -3 can combine in many different configurations so that you always operate in correct multiples. Local override and sub-group control is also possible with these line voltage control relay modules.

The R-1R is the low voltage version of the motor control relays. The R-1R was designed to fit inside the D-8 headrail making wiring easier by placing the relay with the motor. When used with roller shades or drapery tracks, the R-1R is available in an enclosure. The R-1R is activated by dry contacts. With its two parallel RJ-4 jacks the R-1R's can be linked together for group control or be activated by a Home Automation System with a switch override.

The R-1R makes interfacing with Home Automation Systems easy because of its dry contact activation.

Additional controls such as Sun Sensors, Wind Sensors and Time Clocks are available.

Whether your project requires a stand-alone control or integration into a Home Automation type of control, Am-Source can supply you with just the right type of controls.
