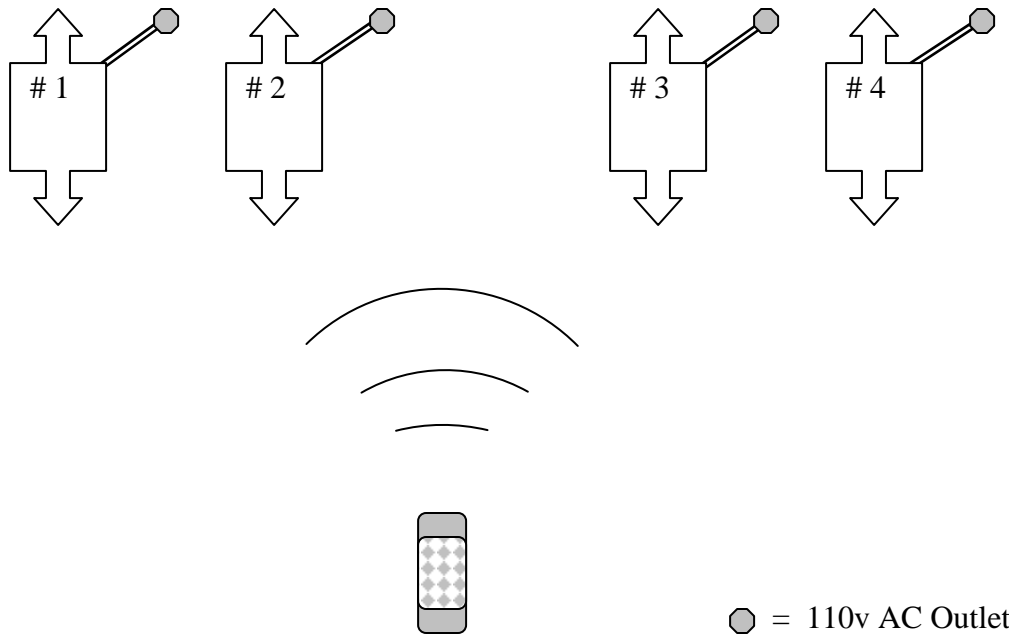


# Radio Control



Radio Control Plug motorized Window Treatment into grounded 110 volt AC outlet. Press Buttons on transmitter which sends out a radio signal to raise and lower treatment. Each treatment is controlled individually.

## OPERATION

1. To operate a window treatment, press a transmitter button.
2. To stop that window treatment direction, press the same button again.
3. To reverse the direction of STEP #1, press the same button a third time.
4. If a window treatment stops by itself by reaching its most upper or lower pre-set limits the transmitter button for that window treatment must be pressed twice to operate the reverse travel operation.

Pro's Normally a simpler installation, typically only requires a 110volt AC outlet. A simple stand alone system that can be linked to Home Automation.. The transmitter's range allows for operation from a larger distance, without having to point at an infrared eye. When used with a D-8 system, receiver is located inside the headrail. When used with a Drapery track, the receiver is enclosed in a box, hidden behind the drapery stack. Each treatment is controlled individually.

Con's Possible radio wave interference. Can not be controlled as a group.
